

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES FOR 2007:

1. COMMUNICATE WITH THE CITIZENS OF LISBON:

- A. Submit a monthly article to the Lisbon Ledger pertaining to local conservation events.
- B. Develop a Conservation Commission brochure.
- C. Evaluate the needs of the community by developing and circulating a survey or questionnaire.
- D. Sponsor a conservation photography contest for students of LHS.
- E. Develop a Conservation Commission letterhead

2. ESTABLISH THE COMMISSION AS A COORDINATING AND REVIEWING AGENCY FOR ALL MUNICIPAL PROJECTS AFFECTING NATURAL RESOURCES:

- A. At least one member of the commission should attend the Town Council meetings.
- B. Contact the Planning Board pertaining to ways the Commission can be of assistance in reviewing subdivisions or updating the comprehensive plan. Both committees are working toward the same overall goal of the best and wisest development of the Town. At least one commission member should attend the monthly Planning Board meetings.
- C. Coordinate activities or meetings with other town organizations such as the Trail Commission, Recreation Committee, Historical Society and Library.
- D. Coordinate with Public Works for tree planting and removal.
- E. Working with Public Works to develop a list of town owned trees.

3. CONDUCT A NATURAL RESOURCE INVENTORY:

- A. Develop an index of all open space areas (public and private), including wetlands, waterfowl areas, unusual geographic features, deer wintering areas, historic sites, waterfalls and unusual plants
- B. Research availability of land for public use
- C. Develop a map of the town's natural resources
- D. Establish a current list of all Town owned properties with tax map locations
- E. Secure conservation easements from large landowners and timber lot owners
- F. Establish boundary lines on town owned woodlots
