


# Beaver Park

## TOWN ORDINANCE FOR TOWN PARKS

The following town ordinances for town parks were accepted at Town Meeting May 23, 1984. These ordinances are to make your visits at Beaver Park and Summer Street Park safer and more enjoyable. Everyone visiting the parks is encouraged to abide by these regulations and aid in their enforcement. Thus, Article 88 was accepted as follows:

**Preamble 301:** In order to promote the general welfare of the citizens of the Town of Lisbon, to provide for the Public Safety and to provide for the protection and maintenance of public parks and to preserve the public peace, the following ordinance is adopted.

### Section 302: FIRE PROHIBITED

A person shall not ignite a fire in any Public Park without first obtaining a fire permit from the Park Ranger, and all fires must be contained in a designated fireplace.

### Section 303: OPEN TIMES

The gates of the park will open from 8:00 a.m. to sunset fall and winter, 7:00 a.m. to sunset spring and summer, except on written authorization from the Park Ranger. The park roads will be closed to 4-wheel vehicles when the park personnel determines the road impassable, however pedestrians will be welcomed.

### Section 304: LITTERING PROHIBITED

No person shall place or cause to be placed on or in Town Parks any refuse of any kind, including but not limited to, glass, metal, wood, paper and trash.

### Section 305: FIREARMS PROHIBITED

The use of any firearm in any Town Park shall be prohibited.

### Section 306: VANDALISM

No person shall deface, paint, damage, mutilate or remove any structure, marker, fauna, flora or any other natural or man-made feature of the parks.

### Section 307: ANIMAL TRAPS

No person shall set animal traps in the parks other than for shiners. One trap will be allowed per person and nets prohibited. All traps must be registered with the Park Ranger.

### Section 308: PENALTY

Any person who violates any of the provisions of Section 302-307 shall be punished upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$100.00.

### Section 309: SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any part or section of this ordinance is judged by proper authority to be illegal it shall not be construed to invalidate any other section of said ordinance.

### Section 310: USER FEE SYSTEM

User fees will be set by the Selectmen. Present fee system accepted by Selectmen is as follows:


Residents: \$ 1.00 per person.  
\$ 15.00 for year-round family pass.

Non-residents: \$ 3.00 per person.  
\$ 30.00 for year-round family pass.

## BEAVER PARK

### RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Disorderly conduct, abusive language, noisy disturbances, or disregard of these rules and regulations will be grounds for immediate removal from the park.
2. Any repeated violations of park rules and regulations or actions which cause damage to park property, interferes with the comfort, enjoyment, or safety of another user, shall be grounds for permanent loss of the right to use park facilities.
3. Park participants will be held responsible for any damage caused by their children. Participants will also be held responsible for the conduct of their children.
4. No person shall have in their possession any intoxicating beverage/substance while on park property.
5. Children (12 and under) shall not be left unattended in the park.
6. Parents/guardians must keep their children with them (under supervision) at all times while attending field activities. *Please do not let them play in the nearby woods, ponds or roads — keep children on the grass area of the field.*
7. The town or ranger will not be responsible for accidents, injuries or loss of property by fire, theft, wind, floods, or other natural acts which are beyond control. Equipment provided at the park is solely for users convenience and used at OWN RISK.
8. Swimming is at users own risk. *Beaver Park does not staff a lifeguard.* Thus, absolutely no rubber rafts, inner tubes, floats or any other floatation devices are to be used in the ponds. One exception is a certified lifejacket.
9. Motor vehicles shall be parked only in the designated areas. Motor vehicles parked elsewhere or on grass will be towed at owners expense.
10. The park speed limit is 15 m.p.h. and must be observed at all times, and drivers must be alert for children and pedestrians, riders of bikes, skiers and other vehicles.
11. Disturbing or careless operation of motorcycles, ATV's, automobiles, or other motor vehicles will be grounds for removal from the park and/or citation by the police.
12. All vehicle traffic is prohibited on the beaches, dam areas, field and hiking/cross-country ski trails. Thus, vehicles include: pedal bikes, dirt bikes, ATV's, snowmobiles, automobiles, trucks and any other motor operated vehicle.
13. Activities that will damage the grass or flowers such as: open fires, unauthorized diggings or off road travel with ATV's, dirt bikes, pedal bikes or 4-wheel drives is strictly prohibited.
14. Trees and shrubs are not to be climbed, hung on or used as poles for game nets or swings. Proper equipment is available or will soon be available.
15. Pets are permitted in the park but must be under owners control and leashed if necessary. Pets shall be kept under supervision at all times and not be allowed to run at large or commit any nuisance in the limits of the park. Dogs are not allowed on the beaches, picnic areas, parking lots, in swimming ponds, on the field during group activities or confined in any area of the park. They are allowed (supervised by owner) on trails and roads only. Violations of this regulation will lead to the removal of both animal and owner.
16. Glass containers are prohibited in the park. Please use plastic container or cans for safety reasons.
17. All trash is **CARRY IN — CARRY OUT.**
18. Only the grills provided by the park may be used for barbecuing with charcoal — wood fires require a fire permit. Park participants may use their own gas grills.
19. No pedaling, soliciting or commercial enterprise is permitted on the property.
