Lisbon residents and business owners are invited to attend a workshop to provide the Planning Board with feedback on the issue of future land use, and opportunities for businesses, on the Route 9 (Ridge Road) Corridor.

A request has been made to the Lisbon Council, and consequently the Council has asked the Planning Board, to review the land use along Route 9 and the potential for business development and commercial uses. The upcoming workshop follows the completion of an informal, online community survey for initial input, and will be an opportunity for community members to share and discuss further the values and vision for the future of Route 9.

The input from both the survey and workshop will be presented to the Council before any further action.

Route 9 is currently zoned primarily for rural and/or residential uses, few non-residential (e.g. commercial) uses are allowed except agricultural business or home occupations. (Details on the allowed uses in each zone can be found in Lisbon's Zoning Ordinance, www.lisbonme.org, or at the town office.)
