#### IV. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Superintendent's Report
  - 1. Propane Contract 2020 Season
    - a. Mr. Alexander handed out spreadsheet with pricing; MW Sewall came in lowest
    - b. Ms. Hale motion to go with MW Sewall, Mr. Bickford 2<sup>nd</sup> followed by 3/0 vote in favor.
  - 2. Generator Maintenance Contract
    - a. Mr. Alexander handed out proposed 3 year contract from Cummins
    - b. Mr. Lemieux motion, Mr. Bickford 2<sup>nd</sup> followed by 3/0 vote in favor of renewing contract
  - 3. COVID-19
    - a. Office opened to the public on June 8<sup>th</sup>
    - b. Mr. Alexander had a door mechanism installed on outside door; public has to be buzzed in. This is for security and to control how many enter vestibule at once.
    - c. The same mechanism will be installed on inside door as well and will remain locked at all times
  - 4. Rt. 196 Main Replacement Project
    - a. Funds Part of 2020 Bond; this project not in original plan but need to replace due to a leak and work needs to be completed before paving date of July 4th
    - b. Design has been completed; replace 8" main with 12" zinc coated pipe from Birch to tie in
      - i. Mr. Alexander to submit road open and utility permit to DOT
    - c. Meeting via Zoom held with Town of Lisbon, Dirigo, gas, CMP and telephone about project areas
    - d. Bid Date June 15th opening
      - i. Bid request sent to St. Laurent and Longchamps
      - ii. Sealed bids due back on June 12<sup>th</sup> by 2pm.
      - iii. Dirigo thinks it will cost around \$75,000-\$125,000. Mr. Alexander believes it could be more due to the short timeline.
- B. Business Manager's Report
  - 1. Office hours will now be M-F 8:30 to 4:00; this is a change from closing at 4:30 on Thursday
  - 2. Abatement request for 11 Second St; issue has been resolved. Abatement is in the amount of \$292.80.
    - a. Mr. Bickford 1<sup>st</sup>, Mr. Lemieux 2<sup>nd</sup> followed by a 3/0 vote to approve.
- C. Commissioner Communication/Requests
  - 1. Ms. Hale-Dig safe markings on Pinewoods? Mr. Alexander confirmed other utilities did mark.
  - 2. Mr. Bickford-None

- D. Customer Communication
  - 1. Complaint Log
    - a. 6/1/2020-4 Booker St-Noise in pipes. Mr. Alexander went to residence and found that it is still the toilet and not an issue with water delivery from Lisbon Water Department.
- E. Customer Comments
  - a. 06/02/2020-6 Sparsam St-Mr. Bradeen sent a comment card, stating it was great working with our staff, Mr. Stevens & Mr. Currier
- F. Other New Business
  - 1. Ann St. Well Pump Lost level indicator in storm on 6/6/20
    - a. AEC Engineering coming to look at PLC to check pressure transducer and if it is sending to SCADA computer-they will repair
    - b. Without the level indicator they lost auto control and are running manually right now.
  - 2. Ross Valve flow meter
    - a. Lost output on flow meter; electrician will confirm where issue is

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- b. Rep stated to Mr. Alexander that the pump is now obsolete so he is pricing a new interrogator so hopefully we will not have to purchase a new pump.
- 3. Sensus meter Meeting with EJP
  - a. Devices to place over touch pads that will allow us to radio read meters without touching the pad; 24 year life
  - b. Some will require new wiring before installing new device
  - c. Town of Lisbon has set aside \$12,500 to help pay for the equipment
  - d. Total cost of project is \$395,000 and was included in the 2020 Bond
  - e. These devices are progression towards transitioning to a fixed based reading system in the future. With fixed based we will be able to read/download information in real time every 4 hours; make it easier to get final readings, alert when high usage is happening, and pressure readings can help detect and find leaks.
  - f. Mr. Lemieux 1<sup>st</sup>, Mr. Bickford 2<sup>nd</sup> followed by a 3/0 vote to approve
